Please note that Israeli Esrogim must be treated with special care, because they were grown in a Shmitta year. (This is the case even though the esrog was grown under Otzar Bais Din.) There are 3 options:

- The esrog should be sent back to Israel.
- The esrog should be allowed to dry and wither. When this occurs, the esrog is wrapped in paper or placed in a bag and discarded.
- The esrog is eaten. However any portion not consumed (such as peels or pits, or left over parts of the flesh) must be left to dry as in the previous option before being discarded.
