Tannaim and Amoraim: R. Zeira

Though born and educated in Bavel R. Zeira wanted very much to emigrate to Eretz Yisroel. Before he would leave, however, he sought the approval of several *gedolim*. R. Yochanan approved but R. Yehudah did not. Weighing his options R. Zeira and his family chose to make the move to Israel. It was not an easy trip. At one point R. Zeira was forced to cross the Jordan River on foot. Upon arrival in T'veriah he went to buy some meat. He paid his bill of 50 *perutot* and then received a slap on the face (for reasons unknown). Thinking this to be the custom of the area he related this to the sages that night. Appalled at what they heard they sought out the seller but, tragically, found that he had died. In spite of all his troubles R. Zeira loved every aspect of Israel. It was he who authored the statement "avira d'ar'ah machkim". The very air of Israel has the capacity of making one wise. R. Zeira, one of the gedolim of Eretz Yisroel, was a humble person who did not want to accept semicha. He relented when he heard that all your transgressions are removed when you receive semicha (I didn't know that). Hundreds of his maamorim appear in the Talmud. He had the practice of fasting 100 days to achieve certain goals. He also had the curious practice every 30 days of testing himself with fire. Once the fire got out of control and he was severely burned by the fire. He then became referred to as ketina charoch shakei" – the short man with scorched thighs. He lived a long life and was honored greatly at his passing.
