Tannaim and Amoraim: Rav Chisda

Rav Chisda was a second/third generation *amora* who lived in Kafri in Bavel. He lived to the ripe old age of 92. In his youth he was extremely poor to the extent that he would eat no vegetables because he believed they increased his appetite. In addition, when walking through brambles he would lift his cloak saying that scratched legs can heal but torn clothes become useless. He then chose to go into the beer making business and became very rich! With much of his wealth he supported his needy students with all their necessities. Rav Chisda was a student of Rav and treasured his every pronouncement to the extent that he declared that he would reward anyone who could tell him a statement of Rav that he did not know. None could, until Rava bar Mechasia presented him with a new *drasha* he had heard from Rav. When Rav Huna became the head of the yeshiva in Sura, Rav Chisda became his close friend and student. They became known in the *gemara* as the "*sovei desura*" – the scholars of Sura. The two of them, though friends, had some fierce halachic disputes. Once Rav Huna declared to Rav Chisda: "I don't need you. You need me". For a long time they would not talk to each other until they realized that the dispute was frivolous and both regretted it. Rav Chisda even took upon himself a 40-day fast to atone for his foolishness. The reputation of the yeshiva in Sura grew by leaps and bounds extending to Eretz Yisroel where Rav Ami and Rav Assi deferred to the scholars of Sura where Rav Chisda was one of its chief scholars. He was a prodigious scholar whose many statements are recorded both in the bavli and the yerushalmi where he is known as Rav Chasdai. Among his writings, it is said, was the authorship of the *tefilat haderech*. If ever the statement *torah u-gedula bemakom echad* – Torah and distinction in one person – applied to anyone, it applied unquestionably to Rav Chisda.
