Sof davar...

Tannaim and Amoraim: Rabban Yochanan ben Zaccai

There have been many great tannaim. But there are a precious few who have reached such super star status that they are known as *rabban*. One of them was Rabban Yochanan ben Zaccai. He lived before the *churban* and ten years after it. He was a student of Hillel and though he was the youngest, Rav saw future greatness in him and described him as "av le-chachmah, av le-doros" a leader in wisdom and a leader of generations. It is said that he spent 40 years in business, 40 years learning and 40 years as a teacher. His first years were spent in the Galil where he was unhappy and complained that the area was filled with ignorant people. In 18 years, he said, only two halachic questions were directed to him. Rabban Yochanan ben Zaccai was a distinguished member of the Sanhedrin and often was involved in debates with the Saducees (tzedukin). One such debate was over the date of Shavuos. The tzedukim claimed that Shavuos always falls on Sunday (based on "memochoras hashabbos") but Rabban Yochanan challenged their contention and insisted that there be one law for all of Israel and that Shavuos was 50 days after the start of Pesach. Rabban Yochanan ben Zaccai knew the *churban habayis* was approaching. This led to perhaps the most famous events he was involved in. Just before the churban he was spirited out of Jerusalem in a coffin by his students and faced the Roman general Vespasian. Unable to prevent the churban, Rabbann Yochanan made three requests of the general. 1. that Yavneh and its scholars be spared, 2. that the direct lineage of the *nesiut* of Hillel be maintained, and 3. that a doctor be provided for R. Zadok. Following the churban, as head of the Sanhedrin and Yeshivas Yavneh he tried to unite the Jews and make sure they would never forget the *churban*. To this end he issued numerous decrees "zecher lechurban". When he fell ill his students came to visit him and asked him to bless them. He did so with the famous statement, "may your fear of heaven be equal to your fear of humans". When asked to explain he said "haleval", I wish our fear of heaven was equal to that of man. Have we advanced further than that today?
