Zack Englander, a twenty year old from the 5 Towns in New York, was recently diagnosed with leukemia. He and several others in the greater Jewish community are in need of a bone marrow transplant and can use your help. Since tissue type is inherited, Zack's best chance of finding a genetically matched donor lies with those of Jewish ancestry. It takes just 30 seconds to swab the inside of your cheek. YOU can make a difference for Zack and other potential recipients. A drive to test for a match will take place on Monday, June 14, 2010 from 6-10 P. M. at the Wilshire Grand Hotel, 350 Pleasant Valley Way, West Orange, NJ 07052. Eligible donors must be between the ages of 18-60 and in general good health. If you were tested in the 1980's or 1990's we ask that you come back and please get retested due to new technical advancements in testing which will help find a match. Tannaim and Amoraim: R. Yose ben Chalafta

Thursday night or Friday (hafrasha should be done

R. Yose is among the most famous of the tannaim of the fourth generation. It is R. Yose who is often referred to whenever there is a statement in the mishna or braiso without an author (stam). He was among the last students of R. Akiva who was his rebbi muvhak, his primary teacher. He wanted to get semicha from his teacher but was prevented from doing so by the Roman oppressors. Instead R. Yose (and four others) received semicha clandestinely from R. Yehuda ben Bava who lost his life in doing so. In his town of Tzippori (Sephoris) he established a bet din that gained world wide acclaim. When the sages recommended the kind of court one should go to with some issue they said, seek out a bet din like the one in Tzippori. One day a distinguished Roman lady came to him and asked, how many days did it take G-d to create the world. R. Yose responded, six. And what did He do after that, she continued. R. Yose answered saying he is mezaveg zivugim, he is busy determining who will marry whom. Upon hearing that the woman laughed and said that it is an easy task and that she can do it too. The following day she lined up her man servants on one side and her maid servants on the other and declared you will marry him and you will marry him, etc. The following day her servants came to her with all kinds of serious injuries. The couples obviously could not get along with each other and were involved in brawls. She retuned to R. Yose the next day and admitted that making a shidduch is not an easy task. R. Yose married his brother's widow after he had passed away without children (yibum.) He earned his livelihood as a manufacturer of leather. His most famous student was none other than R. Yehuda haNasi, the compiler of the mishna. When R. Yose passed away a great tribute was paid to him in the form of the statement that with his passing poska bina - all wisdom and understanding ceased.
