EMERGENCY PARNASSAH FUND

As the 16 month anniversary of the Highland Park/Edison/East Brunswick Emergency Parnasah Fund ("EPI") approaches, we should all take great pride in knowing that through EPI we have collectively as a community provided tremendous support to our friends and neighbors who have fallen on hard times. The EPI committee wants to report on its activities to date and let you know how your support has made a significant difference in the community:

- A total of 32 families have received assistance
- 13 families are no longer in need of assistance (some found jobs, and others, with EPI assistance, restructured their credit card and mortgage debt to a manageable level)
- Except in very limited, extraordinary circumstances, monthly grants per family have not exceeded \$750
- Approximately 80% of funds are paid in the form of food vouchers and 20% in the form of utility or rent checks
- Several EPI families are also being assisted with credit card workout and social work services via a shared financial arrangement between applicant, EPI and applicant's shul
- The fund has expended roughly \$200,000 and current monthly expenses are approximately \$11,000 per month
- Assuming current pledges are fully redeemed and that the number of applicants remains steady, the EPI should have enough funds for another six months
