# Sof davar...

# Tannaim: R. Yehoshua

R. Yehoshua was probably one of the most beloved of all the *tannaim*. It was because of the scholars' love for him that led to the deposing of a *nasi*. It all happened durng a *shiur* being given by the *nasi* Rabban Gamliel. For the third time the *nasi* embarrassed R. Yehoshua publicly and the scholars decided they had had enough. They proceeded to summarily depose him and replace him with R. Elazar ben Azariah. (After apologizing to R. Yehoshua Rabban Gamliel was restored to his post.) He was a student of R. Yochanan ben Zaccai and was praised by his teacher (in Avos) saying "*ashrei yoladeto"* – fortunate is the one who gave birth to him. His mother brought him to shul even when he was yet a baby so that he would be exposed to the sounds of Torah early in his life. He was a very busy man. As a *levi* he served as *meshorer* in the *bet hamikdash*. He was *av bet din* under Rabban Gamliel. He went on missions to Rome on behalf of his people. He was involved in debates with apostates and invariably won. He was not a handsome man. However, when the daughter of the king commented and said "what beautiful wisdom in such an ugly vessel" he countered by serving her very good, expensive wine in an undistinguished, unsavory clay vessel. He lived in the town of Pekiin, between Yavneh and Lod, and was so poor that he supported himself by the manufacture and sale of pins! R. Yehoshua may very well have been beloved even today for, philosophically, he was strongly opposed to excessive *chumros*. Where are the R. Yehoshias of today?
