The Orthodox Forum of Edison/Highland Park will present Dr. Moshe Sherman on the topic "Inheritance or Meritocracy in Religious Authority" on Motzei Shabbat March 2, 2013, 8:00 pm at Congregation Ohav Emeth, 415 Raritan Ave., Highland Park. Dr. Sherman teaches Modern Jewish History and is Associate Dean at the Graduate School of Jewish Studies, Touro College. He is author of numerous articles and books including, "Orthodox Judaism in America: A Biographical Dictionary and Sourcebook" and is editor of "Sefer Kavod HaRav: Festschrift in Honor of the 80th Birthday of Rabbi Dr. Joseph B. Soloveitchik". Dr. Sherman received his Ph.D. from the Bernard Revel Graduate School, Yeshiva University.

Claims of succession by the children of rabbis, roshai yeshiva and Hasidic rebbes have been an occasional phenomenon in Jewish life, at times sparking considerable controversy. Dr. Sherman will present an historical exploration of family members (generally sons and sons-in-law) who claimed the right to inherit their father's position and the responses of Jewish communities through the centuries regarding these claims.
