#### **Kestenbaum Auction**

This past Thursday, June 23rd, Kestenbaum & Co., a New York auction house of rare Judaic books, manuscripts and Fine Art offered for sale by auction important Hebrew manuscripts and rare printed books. Included in the sale were manuscripts of Rabbi Yoseph David Sinzheim (1745-1812) who served for many years as Chief Rabbi of Strassbourg. R. Sinzheim was a prominent member of the Assembly of Notables convened by Napoleon I in 1806, to answer questions regarding the duties and responsibilities of Jews in a French state that now offered rights, freedoms and citizenship. A sermon delivered by Rabbi David Sinzheim in a Paris synagogue in honor of Emperor Napoleon's birthday, August, 1806 apparently strengthened Napoleon's favorable opinion of Jews. One year later, when Napoleon ordered that a 'Grand Sanhedrin' be established to address additional matters of concern pertaining to French Jewry's relationship with a modern state, Rabbi David Sinzheim was appointed Chair of what came to be known as the 'Napoleonic Sanhedrin.' Among his many writings, Rabbi Sinzheim became known for his commentaries on several *masechtot* of Talmud, which when printed were titled *Yad David*. At auction were numerous volumes of handwritten manuscripts by Rabbi Sinzheim and family members, many of which were written during and following the French Revolution. Subsequent generations of extended family copied and preserved these manuscripts, which tragically were looted by the Nazis during Kristallnacht. Remarkably, many of the manuscripts resurfaced in New York, coming to Yeshiva University's Mendel Gottesman Library as early as 1950s. They were returned to family members in 2015 and are now being offered for auction sale. The estimated auction price of the manuscripts was \$70,000 – 100,000 dollars. For a more modest sum, you can purchase beautifully designed, recently printed editions of *Yad David* published by Machon Yerushalayim. Thanks to work at the Yeshiva University archives you can now view a digital copy of all these rabbinic man

The auction also included Chabad related documents, formerly the property of the late Samuel Kramer, an attorney, who served for many years as legal counsel of Agudas Chassidei Chabad of America. Included for sale was Rabbi Yosef Yitzchak Schneerson's record of financial accounts recording the beginnings of Lubavitch Chassidism in the United States, and correspondence between Samuel Kramer and Rabbi Shemaryahu Gourary, R. Yosef Yitzchak's son in law, regarding the rescue of rabbis and students of Yeshiva Tomchei Temimim from war-torn Europe, 1940-41.
