LETTER-WRITING COMMITTEE TO COUNTERACT HATEFUL ANTI-ISRAEL MEDIA BIAS BEING FORMED

Israel is being continuously assaulted physically by Palestinians at home, and also by worldwide and US media, by the U.N., and by US government actions. While some of us complain individually in the form of writing letters to editors and to government officials, the overall effort is useful, but has a rather limited impact. Rabbi Luban has suggested that instead of individual letters in answer to a specific issue, many letters of complaint would have much more of an impact. Accordingly, under his guidance, a committee is being formed in our local area to counteract this one-sided bias by a more organized effort as a force multiplier. What is being envisioned is a core of volunteers to write or email just a few short (one or two paragraph) letters periodically (every week or two) to the appropriate target.
