This Shabbos we continue The Summer Lecture Series as we hear more about the development of halacha from the times of the Mishna until the present day. This week we have the privilege of hearing from Yoni Goldberg about the role of the Rambam and his innovations and contributions in codifying halacha. You will not want to miss it! This unique series will take place for the next five shabbosim in the Social Hall at 6:15 PM after the 6 PM mincha. Please join us!

WARTIME RESUPPLY OF RELIGIOUS ITEMS FOR COMBAT SOLDIERS

From Colonel Yedidya Atlas, IDF Rabbinate:
In the last two months the IDF has launched two significant operations – one primarily focused on Gaza in the south, and this past week's operation in Jenin in Judea/Samaria Division which is part of IDF Central Command. And concurrently to the actual operations, there were increased call-ups of combat reserve units. During these last two operations alone, many thousands of the olive green dri-fit Tzitzit were distributed to the our soldiers together with the pocket sefer Magen Yisrael Tehillim-Siddur for Combat Soldiers (which is especially designed to fit in the fatigue pocket or combat pouch under the bulletproof vest). 13,000 copies of the Magen Yisrael Tehillim-Siddur for Combat Soldiers were reprinted as well as 20,000 more Tzitzit (which back in

the 2014 war in Gaza, the combat soldiers nicknamed: "the real bulletproof vest"). This is in addition to the regular projects I deal with (e.g. 50,000 pairs of said Tzitzit every year for the past 5 years, this coming year being increased to 60,000; Torah Libraries – both for base synagogues as well as pocket size sifrei kodesh for troops in the field to carry with them to enable Torah study in field training and actual combat zones, Sifrei Torah, Sukkot, Tefillin and Mezuzot, et al). Baruch Hashem, what has been distributed in recent months is from the stockpiles of said religious items that was organized more than a year prior in anticipation of the expected current needs. There is no question that there will be more such operations in the coming year given the situation, and I feel it necessary to meet the needs in real time in addition to our regular Mitzvah activities.
