## **RABBI'S CORNER**

There are two important Halachos relevant for the Chazan at our Minyanim that are important to review.

- Before Shemona Esrei begins, the Chazan should say the concluding Beracha of Birchos Kerias Shema out loud, including the words Ga'al Yisrael. While it is acceptable if those two words are said quietly, it is preferable for the entire Beracha to be recited out loud.
- During Chazaras Hashatz, the Chazan must say the entire Beracha of Modim out loud. Ideally, the chazan should pause after saying the opening sentence of Modim and
