RABBIS CORNER

The Halachos of lighting the Menorah in Shul Mincha and Maariv:

- Candles should be lit with a Beracha after the zman mincha
- Candles should be lit with a beracha before the 7:30 Maariv.
- Candles should be lit without a beracha before the 10:10 Maariv except for a night (Sunday) when that is the first Maariv Minyan in that room.

Shacharis:

- Candles should be lit before the first minyan and again before the 8am Minyan. They should remain lit for the 9am Minyan (on days when the 9am takes place).
- Candles should be lit in the Beis Medrash before the 6:55 Minyan. However, when the second Minyan takes place in the social hall, the candles do not need to be lit.
